alization on November 9-11, 2016. There were 81 participants in total, consisting of 32 students and 8 teacher from Aquino School Foundation (Cavite), Inc., 27 students from Upon This Rock Christian Academy, 10 retreat coordinators, and 4 kitchen staff members.

"SAVERS," the name of the organizing team, stands for Serving Advocates of Values through Educational Retreats for Students—the pioneering team founded by Rev. Domingo Ranay. We praise the Lord for giving him the vision of establishing a team that would serve the purpose of having, as he named it, "MOLDS for Christ"— Ministry Opportunity to Lead and Disciple Students for Christ. The team envisions sharing God's truths to students and teachers of different neighboring private schools by organizing fun, creative retreats annually.

The focus of the first retreat is about "Knowing, Trusting, Serving GOD." This theme was reinforced in three different sessions by Pastor Christian Lauron, Bro. Reynaldo "Dong" Plamiano, and Pastor Domingo Ranay, respectively. The messages highlighted the truth that knowing Jesus, i.e., having true relationship with Him, is the most undeserved yet the best gift we could get by trusting Jesus. And without the saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus, we cannot sincerely trust Him, thus, we cannot passionately serve Him, too.
